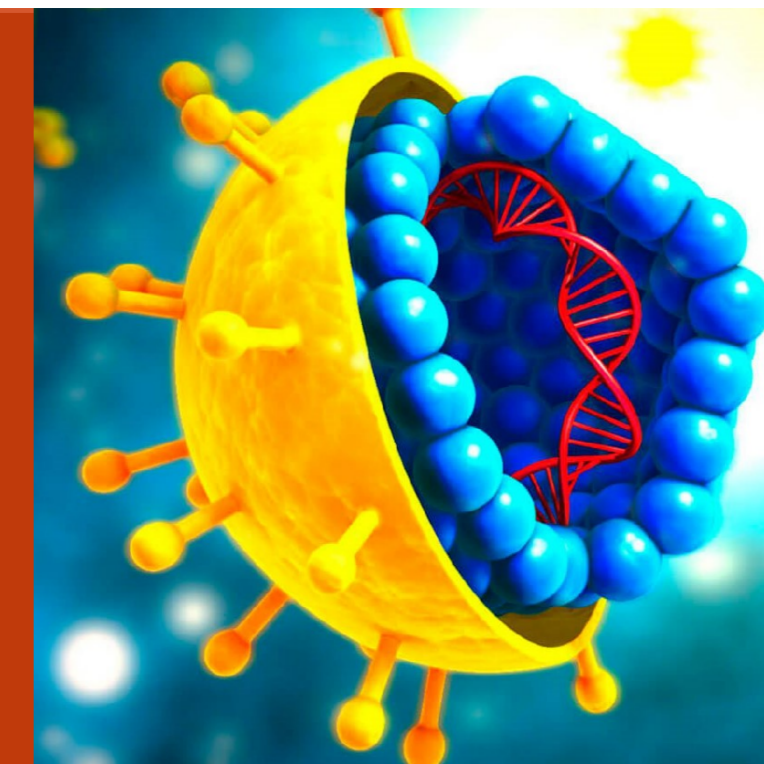

- Screen for Hepatitis C Virus in patients who attend the Opioid Substitution Treatment Program in the Treatment Team of the Integrated Response Center in Figueira da Foz and users of the Direct Intervention Team of the Association Fernão Mendes Pinto

Target Group

- People addicted to alcohol and/or drugs
- Homeless people
- Victims of human trafficking
- Ex-prisoners
- Sex workers
- People in situations of social vulnerability



Project

- Microelimination of Hepatitis C Virus in this population in accordance with the recommendations of the World Health Organization

Innovation

- First Partnership from Coimbra province to execute the program of microelimination
- Decentralization of the screening process to the reference services of the target group
- Guarantee of transportation + technical following (with supervision while taking the medication)

Plan

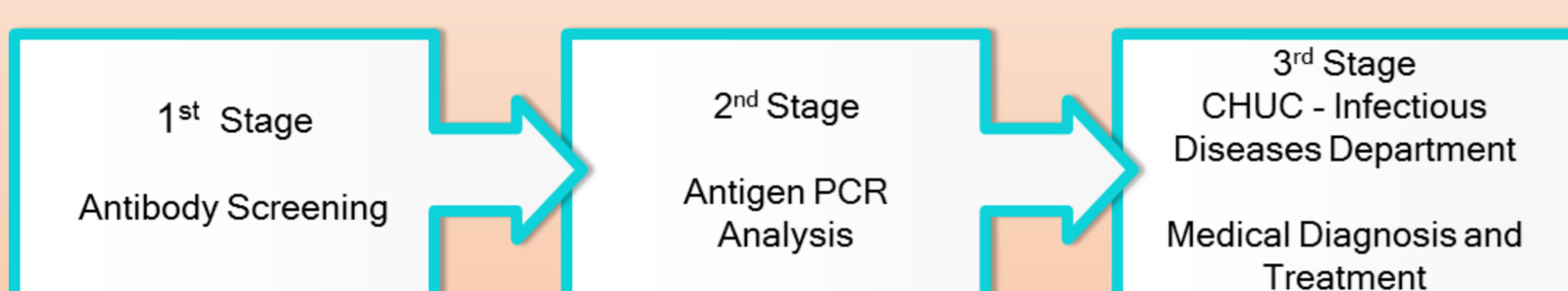
Target Group from AFMP + ET Figueira da Foz

Objectives

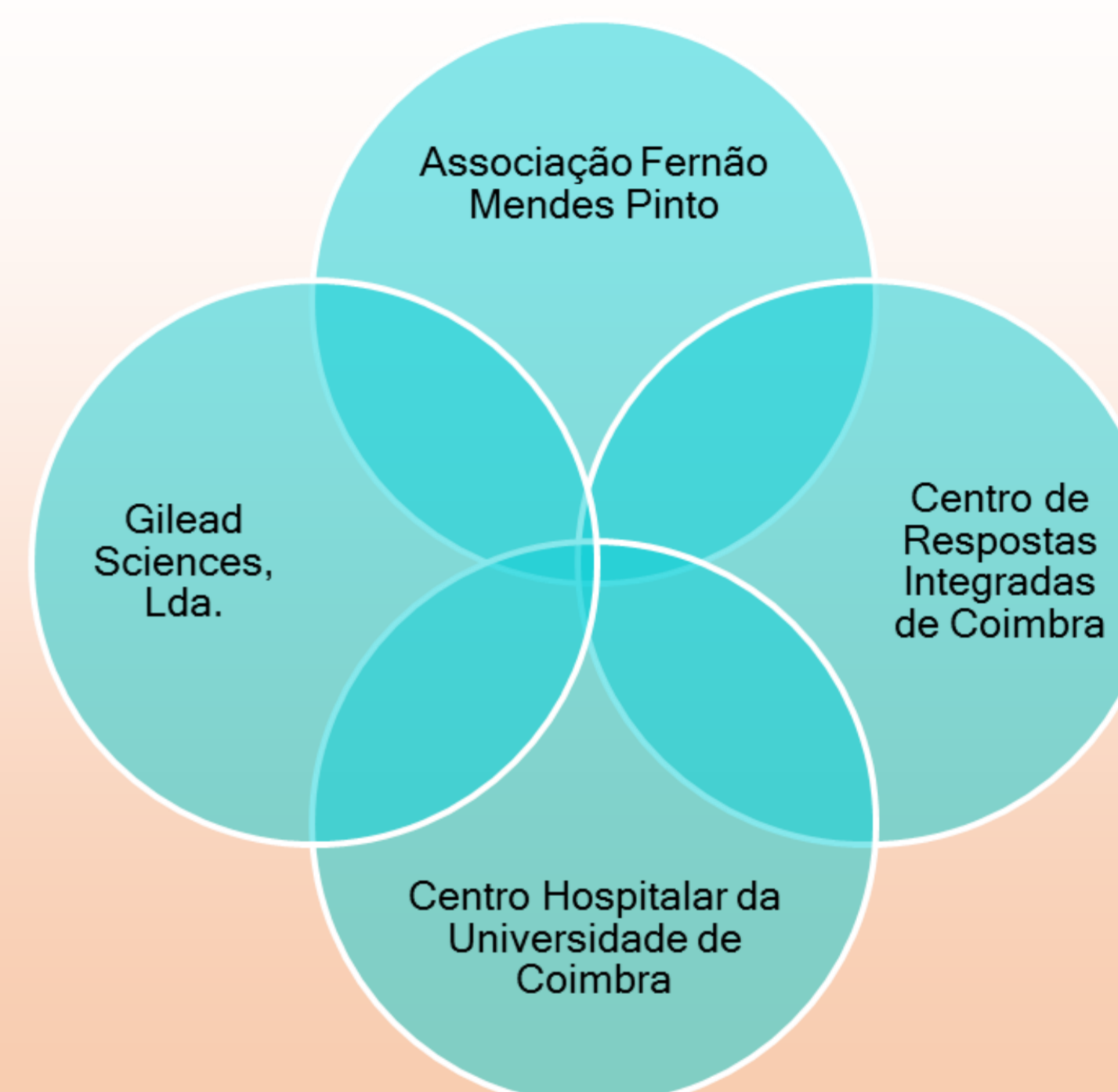
- Track 110 people and identify positive cases of Hepatitis C Virus;
- Ensure access to treatment.
